Do It In Secret

Matthew 6:1 Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 6:3 But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth:

As we continue in 2025, one area of ministry that we should constantly keep under check is our heart posture. In Matthew, Jesus talks about spiritual heart surgery by dealing with people doing things to be seen by men. Those of us called to pulpit ministry must especially watch out for this. But what I am getting ready to say will shock most of you. The way that most churches are fashioned—most of us Christians do a lot of stuff just to be seen by men.

Truthfully, consider the following questions: When you get ready to go to church, do you want your neighbors to see that you are going to church? Do you want people to see that you are carrying the Bible? At church, do you want people to see you giving your money? Do you want people to see you giving praise? Jesus warns us about this. He instructs us not to do things to be seen and applauded by men. Jesus said that this is what the Hypocrites do. Remember, he said, "That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven." Is this a contradiction to what he said in Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. No! Your relationship with God should be public.

Let's look at Jesus' life - He performed miracles, and men saw Him and glorified God. He spoke publicly and preached openly - people heard him and glorified God. But you never hear too much about Jesus' activity in certain areas. One area is giving alms or giving money to people experiencing poverty. Surely Jesus gave to the poor because he told others to give to the poor: Matt 19:21 and Mk 10:21. Why don't we know who Jesus gave to? Because He did it in secret. Certain things done in our Christianity should be done secretly, and one is when we give charitably. I hear Christians boast all of the time, "if it wasn't for my tithes and offerings that I give- this church would go under." Have you ever noticed on Christmas and Thanksgiving how many prominent Pastors or Bishops go and work in the soup kitchen while the Channel 13 News cameras are rolling? They already have their reward. Jesus says that this is what the hypocrites do. When was the last time you gave something in secret? When was the last time you gave to someone and no one knew about it but you and God? Strive to give in secret so that your heavenly Father can reward you!

The Great Commission

Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will follow those who believe: in My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with *them* and confirming the word through the accompanying signs.

Amen.

As I began to ask the Lord what to write about this month, I went to my notes to find out what I had jotted down about signs, wonders, and miracles. Surprisingly, a message I preached in January of 2024 popped up. We are in an evangelistic revival explosion, so I thought it would be fitting to draw from the outlined notes of that message entitled "Cast Out Your Nets."

Here's a portion of my introduction from that message:

"In 2023, after moving into our building (KCOH), I sat on the beautiful backyard swing my husband bought for me, praying in the spirit. As I prayed, I started to sense an urgency to share Christ in a more peculiar way than usual". I sensed it had to do specifically with our church. I began to pray, "Lord, what can I do?" As I began strategizing, I felt the mandate was heavier on the leaders and members who serve, the pastor, and me. I thought that was a little weird. I shared that with the pastor, who stated that he had already been in that vein, getting ready to amp up even more, particularly for the next leg, where we are in the scheme of things now.

Last year, the pastor began to push in on teaching that the church is supposed to win the lost, which is our reasonable service. He poured it out on the leader's calls and wouldn't let up. We joined him in corporate prayer, praying for the hearts of those connected to turn. Asking God for revelation to the hearts of everyone about what a local church body is about. What being a real Christian is really about. Praying and asking God to root out the old regime of weekly church entertainment. The old regime of gathering for a show and instead gathering to be equipped to win people for Christ. Well, last year, we began pushing in on it, and this year, God has supernaturally brought revival. PRAISE GOD. There's an awakening, realigning, revitalizing movement happening right before our eyes.

In Mark 16:15, JESUS GIVES THE CHURCH THE GREAT COMMISSION - 'GO INTO THE WORLD AND PREACH THE GOSPEL'. That's only the beginning of our marching orders. Mark 16:17 clearly is the "B" part of the orders. After we preach and get them saved, we are to cast out demons, speak with new tongues, overcome anything deadly, and lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

So instead of us sitting up in our church walls, impressing each other with how fancy our tongues are. We will have new tongues (of fire) that assist us and activate God's power to deliver, heal and set captives free. Revelation is here; it's no longer an ethereal fantasy or responsibility of the few pastors and evangelists who dare to believe. We are amidst manifestation. We are on the cusp of a revolution, Finally. "IT IS SO EXCITING." We have been set up in all arenas to go all the way in. The dead leaves and unproductive fruit have just about been shaken all off... let's not waste any more time. We don't have any to waste anyway.

GOD HAS NOT GIVEN YOU A SPIRIT OF FEAR BUT A SPIRIT OF POWER, LOVE, AND A SOUND MIND. Let'S ROLL UP OUR SLEEVES, and let'S GET TO PRAYING FOR IT, LEARNING, PRACTICING, AND DOING IT...the A & B part of the great commission.

5 Points For Marriage

Have you ever wondered why God created marriages? Would you like to learn how to have a Godly marriage? In this message, Pastor Rondy dives deep into God's view on marriage and how to keep a Godly marriage in a crazy world with the 5 points below:

1. Your marriage has a Divine purpose and a Divine footprint!

Marriage is about finding the right shoe, the right match! So first thing first is to find your assignment! "Everyman has a Divine assignment and needs a Divine assistant/helper. His wife." Once you know your assignment, there should be something that your marriage produces on earth for God's purpose for you if you are a Christian! What did your marriage accomplish for God?

Scripture reference: Jeremiah 1:5

2. Your marriage is to protect your sexuality!

In this Chapter, Paul tells very clearly that it was God's idea for marriage to protect our sexuality. There should be no need for fornication because the husband's eyes are so focused on their wives, and the wife's eyes likewise should be glued to her husband. Both husbands and wives should be rendering each other "due benevolence." Scripture reference: 1 Corinthians 7

3. Your marriage is to create and produce Godly offspring.

When you and your wife attend church, take your kids as well! You don't give your kids an option to not go to church! You raise your children in the Lord by taking them to a church that teaches them About the Lord at a level they can comprehend! And when your children are taught and raised in the Lord, Great will be their peace! If you raise them in the church and the Bible, you won't have to force Christianity on them! Just present them the truth in God's word. But your actions must also show dedication to the church because kids see your choices over your words! Scripture reference: Isaiah 54:13

4. Your marriage should inspire your kids and single people to be married!

Your kids and others should see a healthy dynamic between you and your spouse. They should sense a healthy marriage when they look at you, not strife, sexual frustration, or hearing you or your spouse express negatively about each other. We need more positive representation of Godly marriages in the church! They should see the favor of God in your marriage and your family.

Scripture reference: Matthew 5:16

5. Your marriage is to represent Christ's relationship with the church.

A married couple should operate like Christ and the church operate! Even though your marriage doesn't start with you being one flesh, it's ok because you both have much to learn! Wives make sure you're lovely and loving. That makes it easy for a husband to love you and keeps him from having a reason not to love you. Husband, make sure you're respectable and making wise decisions! If you continue to make bad decisions, it'll be hard for the women to trust you. Scripture reference: Ephesians 5:31 - 33

Pastor Rondy ended this power-packed message with a confession/prayer for married couples to say daily: "Lord, please let me be the best husband/wife and have the best marriage in this subdivision, church, in my respective city!" This confession is for both the married and singles. Say this everyday in your prayer time and watch God do a work in you and your marriage.






What role did prayer and church community play in your relationship?
